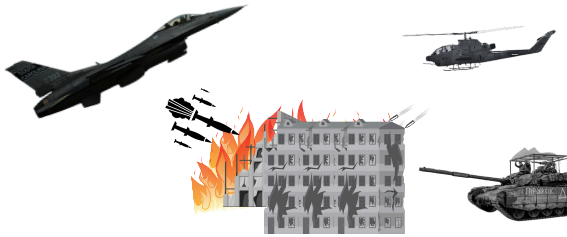

GLOBAL MILITARY SPENDING

- The seven largest economies in the world spent over **\$1.2 trillion** on their militaries last year.
- The total military spending of the world's top 40 military budgets in 2023 was **\$2.4 trillion**.



U.S. MILITARY SPENDING

- The US military budget for 2024 was **\$824.3 billion**.
- “Through Fiscal Year 2022, the United States federal government has spent and obligated **\$8 trillion dollars** on the post-9/11 wars in Afghanistan, Pakistan, Iraq and elsewhere.” - Watson Institute for International and Public Affairs
- The US has sent over **\$61 billion** to Ukraine since the start of the conflict.
- An additional **\$22.76 billion** has been sent to Israel over the last 12 months, totaling over **\$83 billion**.

WE COULD END HUNGER

- The World Health Organization reports **no progress** has been made towards solving world hunger in over 15 years.
- According to Oxfam, \$31.7 billion could **eradicate world hunger ‘in all its forms’**.



WE COULD END POVERTY

- The UN Development Program estimates that just \$14 billion could **lift 165 million people out of poverty**.
- The UN's World Institute for Development Economics Research estimates that for \$325 billion per year, we could **end world poverty by 2030**.
- A sum of \$425 billion could **end world poverty imminently**, which is **less than half** of the US military budget for 2024.

WE COULD PREVENT DISEASES

- The World Health Organization states that \$30.7 billion could **significantly reduce the risk of future pandemics** originating in tropical areas.
- The cost to **eliminate malaria for over two billion people** in the Asia-Pacific is estimated at \$36 billion.



WE COULD PROVIDE UNIVERSAL ACCESS TO EDUCATION

- UNESCO estimates that \$14 billion would **completely end illiteracy** in the 20 countries with literacy rates under 50 percent.
- UNICEF estimated that for only \$1.4 trillion we could **provide every child in the world** with access to **online education from 2021-2030**.
